

Dear Parents/Guardians

I.D. is a youth group that runs on Sunday evenings in a home in Barry and is part of Dinas Powys Baptist Church. For those in years 5-7 the time is 6:00 – 7:15pm and for those in years 8-10 the time is 7:30 – 8:45pm. Those in year 11+ meet on another evening. I.D. is lead by Sarah and Jon who are both trained in safeguarding issues and hold up to date DBS certificates and first aid training.

The group is open to anyone who would like to attend and usually consists of lots of games, some food and often some space to discuss issues that are relevant or important to the young people in the group, including questions of faith and spirituality. Occasionally we will take the group outside and may take part in community projects such as litter picking. They will always be fully supervised when undertaking such activities. These activities are registered with the council and allow the group to collect Time Credits which we will spend as a group on special trips throughout the year.

We have a WhatsApp group for parents where we can give out information quickly and easily to parents about things that are going on. We also have a closed Facebook group where we post information and pictures from the group. (We ask everyone in the group not to copy or share any pictures outside of the closed group).

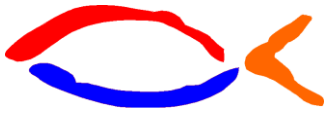
- If you are happy for your child's details to be used to register with the council for Time Credits, then please tick the relevant box on the consent form.
